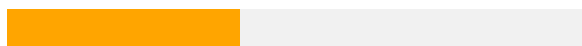

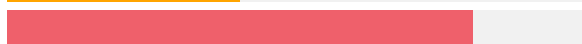
Enjoy a truly unique medical setting experience! Shadow and learn about health care service delivery, as you assist local staff at a rural hospital in Kenya!

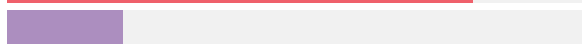

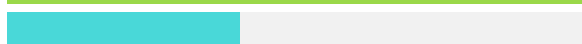

Program Description

Our Medical Program is geared toward increasing your knowledge and experience, while helping the local villagers gain access to quality health care that is affordable.

Kenya continues to be a developing country and its health sector remains a work in progress. Communities, especially those in rural and less developed areas really need healthcare assistance.

In some of the smaller communities, there may be government-owned health care centers and hospitals. Unfortunately, these are often understaffed, with limited facilities and equipment.

You will be pitching in right alongside local nurses, doctors and other medical staff in either a small health care center or a district hospital (depending on the needs at the time). Your level of education, experience, skill, and ability will determine which tasks will be given to you.
