Program Description

Join us in serving this lovely island, Lombok, that was hit hard by the earthquake of July-August, 2018. Hundreds and thousands of people are still displaced from major earthquakes that hit Lombok island then. Families are living under tarpaulin covers at an evacuation center. Like every other person, they too need shelter, water, food and sanitation.

We have decided to provide relief to people impacted by the earthquake in the form of emergency supplies like food, water, and medicine, in addition to longer-term recovery assistance like cleaning up the debris and making the area livable again for the residents.

This program is situated in the west of Lombok. Work in the affected areas by lending a hand to make the day to day lives of the local communities a little easier. Our aid is focused on food and sanitation. You can be of great help in setting up the temporary kitchen and sanitation facilities. You may also help them by supporting our charity programs to collect food, which they lack at the moment. We are currently donating instant noodles, rice, water, toiletries, cleaning equipment, etc with the people. With the coordination of the village head and community leader, we will continue to provide support by lending a hand in rebuilding villagers' houses.

After the completion of these activities in West Lombok, they will be carried on in the North.

Tuesday to Friday

Now that you have planned your activities for the week, mornings will be utilized in planning and post lunch will be the implementation of the plan. The activities and contribution of effort will be planned on the ground with the help of our coordinator and you will concentrate on affected areas of Lombok island.
