Le Morne represents one of the most significant global commemorations to the memory of the slave resistance. Not only does the region evidence a rich and remarkable oral history but in 2008 it was inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site precisely for this remarkable role.

About the Accommodation

Participants will stay at our centre which is located in the Le Morne area, yet can vary depending on the project. All participants are expected to be environmentally responsible and to use all resources with restraint, especially water, paper and electricity. You will be expected to clean up after yourself, and to play your part to keep the accommodation neat and tidy. There are refrigerators at the accommodation for participant's convenience. Bathrooms have hot water facilities and all rooms have wall-fans to cool off.

Breakfast is western style and lunch and dinner would be a mix of western and typical Creole style food.

ATMs, supermarkets, and medical facilities are available within 5km radius from the accommodation.
