Aims & Objectives

To support the local communities by engaging in construction and renovation activities which would aid them to improve their living standards.

Schedule

Monday to Friday

- Working with the local foreman and Le Morne community to renovate an unused house for the community daycare center.
- Stripping the older paint layers and breathing in a fresh perspective with paint & brushes.
- Painting animals, trees and designs from the surroundings that will conjure up the curiosity of the toddlers in the rooms.
- Using Carpentry that can create a safe structure to nurture a creative playtime for the toddlers as well as providing an element of physical development.
- Creation of a small garden in the gardens of the daycare center that will usher colors.
- Masonry & bricklaying under the local foreman.
- Tiling and waterproofing of the daycare center.
- Creation of storage and enclosed spaces for keeping the items required in the daycare center.
