Location

You will be situated amid the beautiful Brazilian City of Manaus, which has a long history that has also included another name (Barra do Rio Negro). Manaus is located in northwestern Brazil, right in the middle of the Amazon rainforest, and has a population of two million.

Although this magnificent city is 1400 km inland - away from the Atlantic Ocean, the water isn't far away at all, as it just happens to be where the Rio Negro joins the Solimões to form the Amazon River. The river tours here are amazing, and if you get lucky, you may even spot some pink dolphins. If not, there are plenty of river beaches, where you will count yourself just as lucky to relax and enjoy yourself underneath their lush trees.

With its river access and close proximity to to the rainforest, this city can basically offer everything Amazona. From flora to fauna to indigenous tribal traditions, Manaus is fast becoming quite popular. Yet, it has been able to retain its own unique sense of charm and mystique by keeping its strong culture alive.

About the Accommodation

You will either be staying at the participant house or in a homestay where you will be living in a real brazilian home with one of our students.

Food Arrangements
