Program Description

Engage with the local children through this rural kindergarten program!

You have the power to enlarge their horizons, enthusing them about school and even teaching them some basic english, a skill that will be invaluable as they grow into adulthood.

You'll find the children are about 4-6 years old. They are mainly from the poor villages in and around the area and you can expect they will be very excited to see you, as you may be one of the few westerners they have ever met!

Like most kindergartens throughout the world, the teaching method here is informal, and the children will want to play with you more than be 'taught' in a formal sense. If you can start to get them enthused about coming to school, and perhaps give them a few very basic English phrases such as simple greetings, you will have done a great job - and hopefully an enjoyable one too!

As a helper in the Kindergarten & Pre-school program, you may like to provide assistance to the Care Centre Manager in several ways:

- Help look after the children's well being and hygiene.
- Provide general assistance to the teachers
- Play with the kids
- Design and lead some games in English

- Lunch
- Afternoon: Preparation for next day's classes
- Dinner
