Program Description

This program consists of working with students at various schools teaching English. We have strong relationships with several primary and secondary schools and the age of students may be anywhere between 4 and 21.

The schools accept a non-formal approach to teaching. This means that we will not have to conform to the local Thai teaching methods or style and you will be free to choose your own way of teaching and may bring new ideas into class.

Our teaching program serves a dual purpose: of course, it is meant to help children in rural Thailand to have a chance to speak more English (usually even their teachers aren't up to standards). Secondly, it will give you an insight into the Thai education system, as well as a good chance to develop friendships with students and teachers.

Aims & Objectives

For this particular program, the aims and objectives fall under the jurisdiction of the Thai government. In recent years, the government has placed a continued emphasis on the teaching of the English language. Despite this, English literacy rates in Thailand remain one the lowest in Asia.

Our aim is to continue to improve the children's prospects by teaching them English. On the other hand, you will also gain teaching experience, an invaluable life skill!

Schedule

Monday to Friday

You will leave the center between 7 and 9 in the morning depending on the school. Expect to teach for 3-6 hours. Lunch will be served at the school and you will leave the school each day at around 3 or 4 in the afternoon.

Thai schools show respect to the King of Thailand through a ceremony and you might be asked to take part this unique morning ritual.

Please take note of the long holidays (mid-March till mid-May and October) as well as public holidays. During such times you can join special classes and English camps that are regularly requested by the local community.
