Program Description

The kids at the kindergarten in Senggigi are right at the start of their school years and the chance to start learning English at such an early age will prove invaluable for them in the future. As in kindergartens throughout the world, the teaching is informal as the children will want to play with you more than be 'taught'. However, by simply getting them interested in coming to school, giving them some very basic English phrases such as simple greetings, you may well have sown the seeds of a lifelong learning habit. The children will all be excited to see you and be exceptionally welcoming, partly due to the natural and genuine friendliness of the people of Lombok but also due to the fact that you will be one of the few foreigners they have ever met!

Aims & Objectives

To support local kindergartens by helping to take care of the children, playing with them and teaching them basic English.

Schedule

Monday to Friday

After an early morning breakfast, you will leave to the kindergarten to teach little children nursery rhymes, basic English phrases, etc. Typically, you will be at the kindergarten in the morning for 2 hours. You would have to share the class with the local teacher. You can take up the class for 1 hour and in the other 1 hour, you will be assisting the local teacher while they are teaching. After lunch, you will have time to plan and organize activities for the following day.

This schedule can be changed and/or amended depending on weather conditions, local conditions and unforeseen circumstances.
