Help out at a local children's home in Peru and be a part of improving the lives of the physically and mentally disabled children from the streets.

This program is for those looking to assist this special needs center in a variety of ways. You will be part of daily therapy sessions, helping the local staff with disabled care, and interacting with these special children. After this program you are sure to gain a new appreciation for life and caring for others!



Program Description

Spend some of your time at this special home for children (and some adults) with physical and mental disabilities. This program is perfect for those looking to work with children that require a higher level of care and assistance.

You will be helping to take care of roughly 30-40 children, as well as assisting the program staff with their daily tasks. Majority of these children are from the streets who have either been abandoned by their families or have lost their parents due to misfortunes and, as such, are highly at risk of exploitation, child abuse and extreme poverty.

Your role will involve assisting and working side-by-side with an established child protection and development organisation (Chibolito Association) in carrying out their main goal of maximising what these children can do on their own, with the hope that one day they are able to get jobs and live fulfilling lives.

Activities you can look forward to from this program include therapy sessions, educational lessons, dancing lessons and outdoor activity. You might also find yourself helping to make classroom materials, painting, cutting firewood, and organising the facility.

These activities fall under one of two sub-programs; assisting the local staff in dealing with special needs children inside the facility or be involved with workshop programs. The Special needs care program provides important education to children from the ages of 7 - 15 who lack discipline and concentration and many other areas of concern (majority are normal children).

Alternatively, workshop programs involve teaching life skills to children and adults between the ages of 16 - 30 years. These workshops require you to teach vital life skills that will help them further their opportunity in life. Workshop programs may include carpentry, arts and crafts, building, etc.

All participants must have a sense of initiative and understand that teachers at the project might not speak the same language
