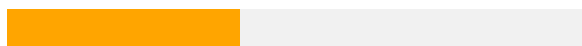

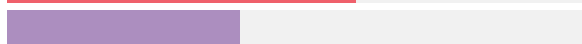

Program Description

Children from ages 3 to 6 years old will be in attendance and you will be able to work directly with them, leading them in song, playing games and other fun educational activities. You will work alongside local teachers who are dedicated to preparing these children for the structure of a school setting, as they transition from home to school. You will be able to teach the children simple English words and phrases and maybe even learn a bit of Vietnamese while you are there too.
