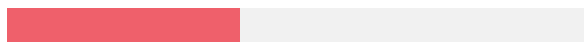
Care for the animals who are neglected and need care and affection.

adopted by a loving and caring family.

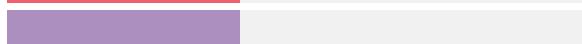

Program Description

Balinese dogs are by nature free-roaming animals that have wandered the streets of Bali for thousands of years. Around 90% of these street dogs have a place where they “belong” (whether it’s at a family home or a local warung for example), however, this doesn’t necessarily mean that these dogs are properly looked after or are regularly fed.

In this program, you will be contributing your time and effort at a dog shelter where you will look after and help rehabilitate these street dogs until they are ready to be adopted by a loving and caring family.

You would be taking the dogs for walks, feeding them, cleaning them and their shelters and socializing with them so that they become more adaptable to humans and become ready for adoption.

Program Duration & Availability

Min duration (weeks): 1
Max duration (weeks): 12

Aims & Objectives

To give a helping hand to care for the homeless, illtreated and sick dogs so they are ready to be adopted by loving homes.

Schedule

Monday to Friday

You will work at the dog shelter from 9:00 to midday and then again in the afternoon from 14:00 to 16:00. Your daily tasks will include,

- Walking, feeding, cleaning the dogs and their shelters
- Socializing with the dogs to make them more adaptable to humans and are ready for adoption
- Distribute the posters and brochures around the Ubud area

This schedule can be changed and/or amended depending on weather conditions, local conditions and unforeseen circumstances.

Additional Requirements

2 x rabies pre-vaccinations to be acquired over a 1 one week period.

Proof of vaccination is required via email before the commencement of the project

Show all three Vaccine certificates to the project staff at the commencement of the program

Participants above 65 should have medical clearance.

With regard to Attire

- No clothes with stomach, lower back, sides of torso showing
- Shorts/skirts should be longer till mid-thigh
- No clothes showing underwear
- No swimwear (bikinis etc.)
- No crude slogans (including profanity) or crude pictures, promoting alcohol or drugs on clothes (no Bintang shirts etc.)
